High Holiday Youth Program + Youth Services

Registration and Information

IMPORTANT MESSAGE:

We believe it is important that children actively participate in the main services or youth programs. Children 'hanging out' in the lobby of the JCC will be asked to return to the main sanctuary or attend the age-appropriate High Holiday Youth Program. We strongly suggest you discuss with your child where they prefer to be during services.

Pre-registration for the Youth Program (infant to 6th grade) is recommended and is the most cost-effective plan to keep everyone engaged and occupied each day of the holiday season.

What is the difference between the Youth Program and Youth Services?

The **Youth Program** is the **pre-registered** and **pre-paid** program for **infants and youth through 6th grade** designed to engage minds and enrich the High Holiday experience for the youth in attendance. *See below for program information.*

The various **Youth Services** that are offered are age-appropriate services for children infant through 12th grade. These are free to attend and do not require prior registration. Please note: *the Young Family Service does require a parent to attend with the child(ren). See reverse side of this form for more information.*

Program Description

Infants and Toddlers (up to 18 months)	Or Tzion provides childcare from <i>Arizona Lullaby Guild</i> for our youngest participants. These professional babysitters are certified in CPR and First Aid. Children in this age range take part in story time and will be provided with toys and age appropriate art materials.
Preschool/Pre-K (18 months+)	Children in preschool and pre-kindergarten will have a variety of programs including story time, arts and crafts, and age appropriate toys and activities.
Kindergarten to 3rd Grade:	Children in these grades will enjoy a fun and educational morning of holiday-themed activities including: storytelling, an age appropriate youth service, team building, Jewish learning activities, and a craft/service project.
4th grade to 6th Grade	Children in these grades will enjoy a fun and educational morning of holiday-themed activities including: an age appropriate youth service, team building, Jewish learning activities, and a craft/service project.

Youth Services

The Youth Services are designed for all children from infant to 12th Grade and pre-registration is not required. We strongly recommend that all children attend their age-appropriate service in order to appreciate the beauty and traditions of the holidays.

Service times will vary by day, please check our website for times and locations or refer to the information posted in the JCC lobby during the High Holiday services. *See below for a description of each service.*

Young Family (infants to Pre-K)	These fun and engaging services are for infants through Pre-Kindergarten and their families. These services are <u>separate</u> from the High Holiday Youth Program and we require that parents attend and participate with their child(ren) in these musical and smile-filled experiences. Older siblings are also welcome to join in the fun!
Haverim ('friends!') Services (Kindergarten to 3 rd grade)	These services are interactive, experiential Jewish learning opportunities for children in grades Kindergarten to 3 rd grade that include songs and <i>Tfilot (prayers)</i> . Parents, we thank you in advance for allowing us to create and enjoy a special experience <u>for your kids only!</u> It is not necessary for parents to attend.
Junior Congregation (4 th to 6 th grade)	These services are for youth in 4th to 6th grades. The goal of Junior Congregation is to encourage students to participate in the ritual celebrations of the High Holidays in an age-appropriate setting. Participating youth will be invited to help lead prayers as a part of these engaging and educational services.
